In this week's Parsha, Parshas Chukas, Aharon dies. After Aharon died, all of Bnei Yisroel were sad. Chazal explain that Aharon loved peace and would always make peace between anyone who had a disagreement. Now, do we really think that Aharon broke up fights between everybody? The Mefarshim explain that of course not all of Bnei Yisroel fought. However, once a few people begin to fight, it starts to rub off on others, creating an environment where fighting is acceptable. The Medrash is teaching us how quickly something can spread, both for the good and for the bad. We also learn the importance of having a good environment, surrounded by good people. Aharon helped create a positive environment, something that was appreciated by all. In Camp Shalom we strive to create an atmosphere of Torah, ruach, and good middos where campers can feel safe and have fun!! This is accomplished by each camper coming to camp with a smile on his/her face, excited to have a fun filled day. This positive attitude will rub off on other campers and counselors, creating this amazing atmosphere of Torah, middos, and fun.
