In Parshat Pinchas, Moshe is reminded that he will not enter Israel and he asks Hashem to appoint a new leader and Hashem chooses Moshe's closest student, Yehoshua.

Hashem tells Moshe to place his hand on Yehoshua's head. Moshe, however, puts both of his hands on Yehoshua's head to show his full support for Yehoshua. With this action, Moshe continues to teach us how to be a true leader.

The future of the Jewish people is more important than one's own preferences. Moshe was able to set aside his personal wishes for his sons to succeed him, in order to focus on the needs of the Jewish people.
